



Subdivision & Development Appeal Board

PURPOSE:

The Subdivision & Development Appeal Board (SDAB) hears appeals from municipal subdivision and development authorities. SDAB decisions shape the community and affect the lives of developers, neighbours, citizens and businesses. It is important that the public have confidence in the quality of these decisions and the decision-making process.

MEMBERSHIP:

The Board shall consist of five members who shall be appointed by resolution of Council and be composed of:

1. Two (2) members of City Council
2. Three (3) members at large, being residents of the City of Leduc
3. Council shall also appoint, by resolution, two (2) alternate members: one (1) member of City Council and one (1) member at large, being a resident of the City of Leduc.

TERM:

Members of the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board are appointed for a staggered three (3) year term.
