A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF LEDUC IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PRESCRIBE SPEED LIMITS ON HIGHWAYS OR ROADWAYS IN THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES

The *Traffic Safety Act*, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter T-6, as amended, grants a municipality the authority to prescribe maximum speeds or minimum speeds of all or any party of any highway or roadway within the City of Leduc. *Deletion & Replacement – Bylaw 742-2010 adopted April 12, 2010*

AND, in accordance with the Act, Council finds it desirable to pass a Bylaw pursuant to the *Traffic Safety Act*; *Deletion & Replacement – Bylaw 742-2010 adopted April 12, 2010*

THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Leduc in the Province of Alberta duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

PART I: BYLAW TITLE

That bylaw shall be known as the "Speed Bylaw".

PART II: DEFINITIONS

Alley:	a narrow highway providing access to the rear of buildings and parcels of land.
City:	the Municipal Corporation of the City of Leduc.
City Manager:	the Chief Administrative Officer of the City, as appointed pursuant to <i>the Municipal Government Act</i> .
Council:	the Council of the City.
Highway:	any thoroughfare, street, road, trail, avenue, parkway, driveway, viaduct, square, bridge, causeway, trestle way or other place, whether publicly or privately owned, any part of which the public is ordinarily entitled or permitted to use for the passage or parking of vehicles.
Peace Officer:	a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, a Bylaw Enforcement Officer, or Special Constable appointed pursuant to the provisions of Section 38 of the <i>Police Act, 1980, Chapter P-12, Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980</i> .

PART III: APPLICATION

SPEED

1. Maximum speed on all highways shall be 50 kilometres per hour (km/hr) except as listed below and illustrated on Schedule A of this Bylaw:

- i) On all Alleys within the City of Leduc Corporate Limits.
- b) 30 km/hr

 - iii) Highway 2 West Service Road both directions from 65 Avenue to 50 Avenue.

 - vi) Sparrow Drive both directions from 700 meters north of 65 Avenue to Airport Road.

OFFENCE

2. Persons who fail to comply with a Direction issued under Section 3 of this Bylaw, within the time specified, is guilty of an offence and is liable to the penalties imposed under this Bylaw.

PART IV: PENALTIES

3. If a Peace Officer believes that an offence has been committed under this Bylaw, a summons under Part 2 of the *Provincial Offences Procedures Act, R.S.A. 2000, P-34* as amended, may be issued by means of a Violation Ticket in respect of an alleged contravention.
4. The penalty payable upon conviction for an offence under this Bylaw shall be in accordance with the *Alberta Traffic Safety Act and its Regulations. Deletion & Replacement – Bylaw 742-2010 adopted April 12, 2010*

ENFORCEMENT

5. The City is not required to enforce this Bylaw. In deciding whether to enforce this Bylaw the City may take into account any practical concerns regarding enforcement including the funds available under the municipal budget and available personnel resources.

SEVERABILITY

6. If at any time any provision of this Bylaw is declared or held to be illegal, invalid or ultra vires, in whole or in part, then that provision shall not apply and the remainder of this Bylaw shall continue in full force and effect and shall be construed as if it had been enacted without the illegal, invalid or ultra vires provision.

PART V: REPEAL

7. Bylaws 48-1985, 171-1989, 192-1990, 1099-1975 and Part 3 of Bylaw 46-85 in its entirety are hereby repealed.

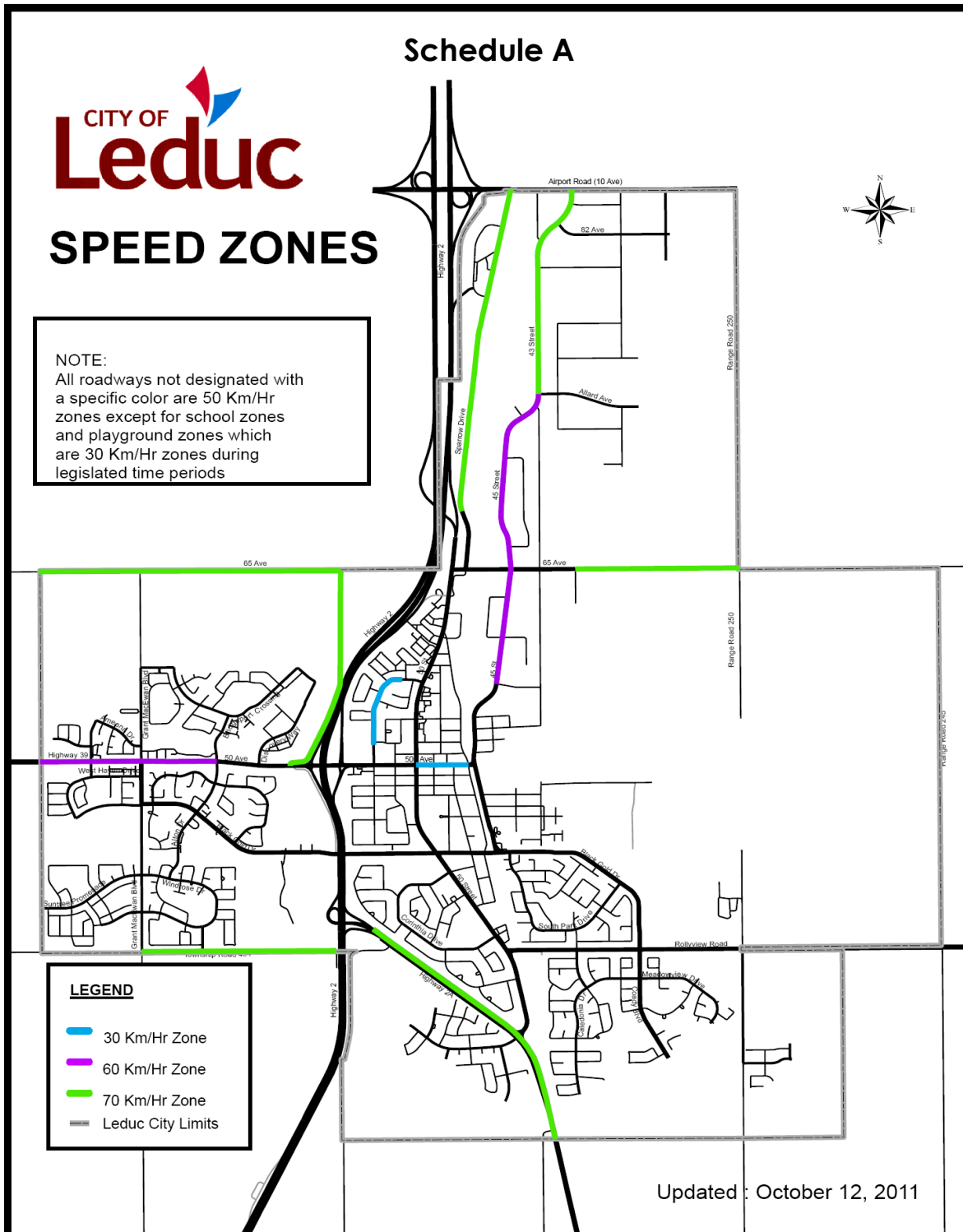
