Playin in the Park is a free program designed to get children outside and participating in games, nature based crafts and activities during the months of July and August. COUNSELLORS IN TRAINING



The Counsellors in Training program is a youth development program whereby youth ages 12-17 volunteer their time to learn the skills necessary to become a camp counsellor. All CITs must complete the CIT training and orientation program held the week before Leduc Summer Camps start. Following training, CITs will take part in a minimum of 2 weeks or 10 classes placement depending on their age and experience.

Youth interest in the program must submit a resume and cover letter to programs@leduc.ca no later than June 14, 2019. All applicants will be contacted for an interview. Successful candidates will then register for the CIT program. Registration includes a program fee of \$50, complete all registration forms and sign a behaviour and confidentiality agreement.

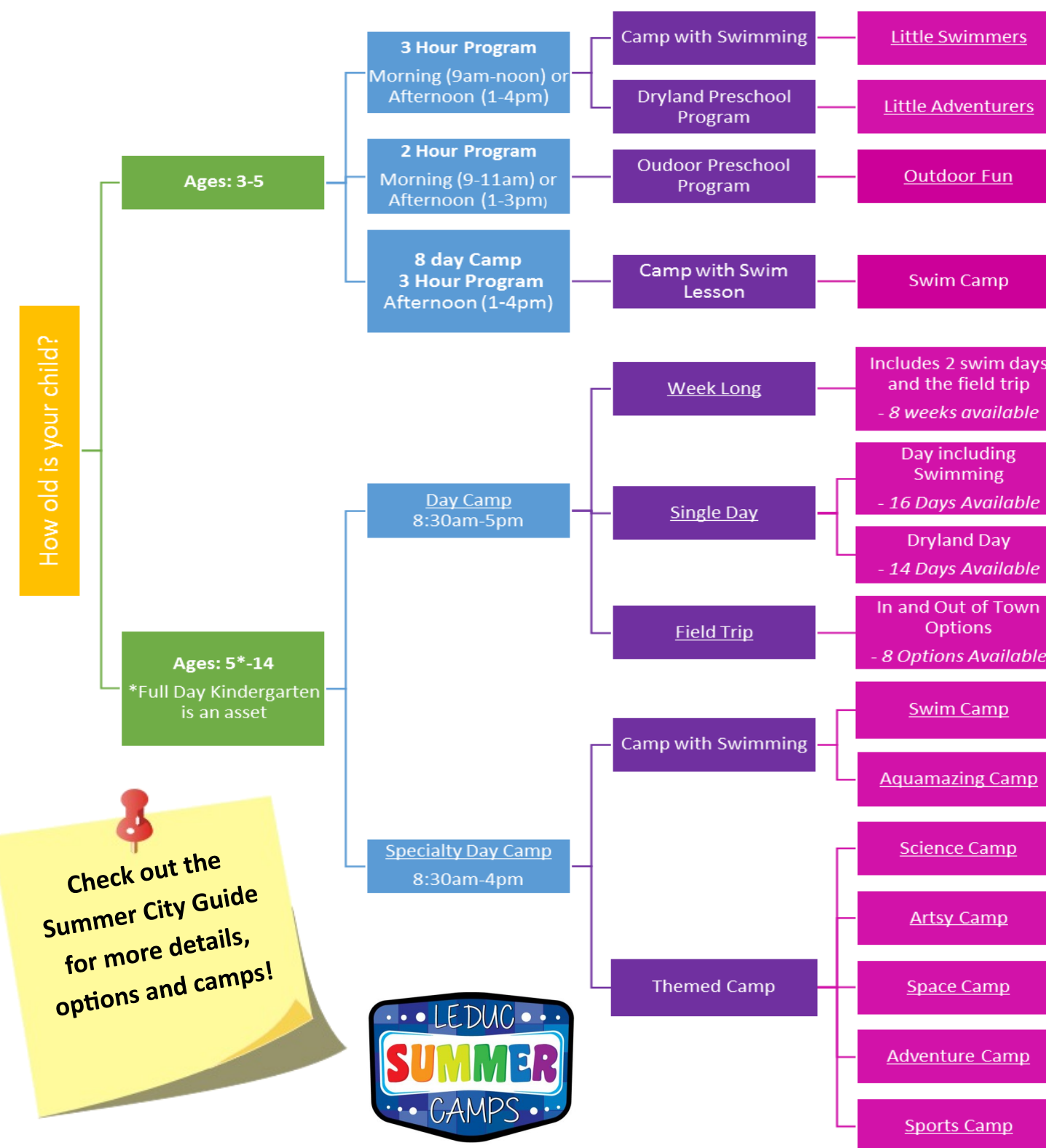

Little Adventurers—MNP Room at the LRC
