- The Sports Hall of Fame Awards are designed to recognize, on an annual basis, up to four outstanding athletes, teams, leaders or builders that have created an impact on our City/County and the community of sport.
- The chosen recipients will be recognized annually each year.
- Award winners will be notified in writing prior to the presentations.
- Deadline for nominations is 4:30 p.m. on Friday, May 22, 2020.

LEDUC SPORTS HALL OF FAME AWARDS

General Induction Criteria:

- Nominee(s) must be an athlete, team, builder or leader within the sporting community.
- Nominee(s) must have lived within the City of Leduc or Leduc County and/or have been involved in a Leduc sport organization in order to be eligible.
- Nominations can be submitted posthumously.

Specific Induction Criteria:

Athlete

- An Athlete shall be evaluated with respect to their contribution to sport at the provincial, national, international and professional levels; or
- The athlete will be evaluated on their personal achievements, awards or accomplishments but also on the impact they made to their sport in the City of Leduc.
- Athletes do not have to be retired from competitions in order to be nominated.













Team

- A team nomination requires at least 50 per cent of its members consist of City of Leduc or Leduc County residents.
- The team will have competed at a western, national or international competition and/or the team will have won at the highest level of competition.
- The team had to have made an impact on sport in Leduc.
- A group of Leduc athletes competing together on a non-Leduc team may also qualify for the team award.

Builder/Leader

- A builder/leader directs athletes in a leadership capacity and has made a major contribution to the development of sport in Leduc.
- A builder/leader shall be recognized for their initiative/leadership and dedication to sport in Leduc.
- A builder/leader is or was a coach, manager, official, administrator, trainer, and a volunteer, a group/team of volunteers, facility/program developer, or media member.
- A builder/leader may be either active or inactive to be considered and shall be evaluated for their outstanding effort in one or more sports, normally over a period of at least ten (10) years, but not necessarily consecutive. Special consideration may be approved by the committee.
- A builder/leader nominee will be evaluated on the impact he/she made to sport in Leduc.

*Exceptions may be made at the discretion of the Leduc Sports Hall of Fame Committee













Nomination Procedure

- Nominations must be submitted from the public or Leduc Sport Hall of Fame Selection Committee.
- Only successful nominations will be notified. All other nominations will be kept on file for three years after which time the nomination must be resubmitted.
- The nominator is responsible for submitting a complete application with all pertinent details and may be contacted for clarification, if necessary.
- Nominations will remain on file and will be reviewed annually for three consecutive years. After three years Nominee(s) must be resubmitted in order to be considered.
- A maximum of four (4) inductees per year.
- Inductions may not occur annually if suitable candidates are not received.
- The Leduc Sports Hall of Fame Selection Committee will review all nominations and, based on the outlined criteria, select the recipient(s).

Recognition

- The recipient(s) will receive a Leduc Sports Hall of Fame award presented by a dignitary or a member of the Leduc Sports Hall of Fame Selection Committee.
- The recipient(s) contribution, accomplishments and recognition will be publically displayed in the City of Leduc.
- All recipients of Leduc Sports Hall of Fame will be invited to attend the community recognition function hosting the Leduc Sports Hall of Fame Induction.


