Proposed repealing of Bylaw 772-2011

City of Leduc / Leduc County Intermunicipal Development Plan

Under the *Municipal Government Act* (MGA), the City of Leduc may, by bylaw, repeal an Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP). The proposed bylaw to repeal the IDP must be published to allow citizens an opportunity to clarify what is proposed, ask questions, or present objections at a required public hearing held prior to Council approving the repealing bylaw.

Bylaw No. 1118-2022

The purpose of proposed Bylaw No. 1118-2022 is to repeal Bylaw No. 772-2011 - City of Leduc / Leduc County Intermunicipal Development Plan. As members of the Edmonton Metropolitan Region Board, the City of Leduc and Leduc County are not mandated under the MGA to have an IDP. The repeal will allow the City of Leduc to focus its resources on the review of the Growth Plan and the maintenance of its own statutory plans. The MGA grants a municipality the authority to repeal a bylaw, and the City of Leduc/Leduc County IDP outlines the process for repeal.
