



# PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS CHECKLIST



## **Adolph Comm Park**

Adolph Comm Park is located in South Park and is equipped with a playground, a tot lot and benches, and has a trail connection at the northeast end.



## **Aileen Faller Park**

Has a sledding hill, 2 baseball diamonds and an outdoor boarded rink with basketball and pickleball lines painted.



## **Alexandra Park**

This 5-hectare community park is one of the most popular sites for leisure activities in Leduc. It has a large pond area complete with fountains and walking trails throughout, along with two playgrounds, outdoor pool/spray park and a picnic shelter.



## **Barclay, K-9 and Outlook Off-Leash Dog Parks**

## **John Jackie (Blackstone) Park**

Gather your mates and explore the nautical pirate themed playground. John Jackie Park has a storm pond, outdoor boarded rink with basketball and pickleball lines painted on it and multiway.



## **Caledonia Park**

Located at Caledonia Park School, Caledonia neighborhood Park is a large open space with two playgrounds, picnic tables and bike racks. It also includes a backstop and soccer field. The park is also connected to the multiway system.



## **Constable Jose Manuel Agostinho Park**

This park in Southfork has a playground with a picnic shelter and seating area.




## **Corinthia Park**

This large park is adjacent to the Ecole Corinthia Park School and connected to the multiway system. This open space features soccer fields, a baseball diamond, playground and a skatepark.



## **East Elementary School**

Located in the South Telford neighborhood, this school park has three playgrounds along with a backstop, basketball nets and a mini soccer field. There is also a naturalized pond with a gazebo and boardwalks. Come for one park and get three great playgrounds with a variety of features, climbing wall, unique rope/chain, slides, ropes, rope chain bridge!



**Edward Wolfe Park**

This open space located in the Willow Park neighborhood contains one of Leduc's child friendly tot lots. Perfect for 2 - 5-year old's (preschool age).

**Fred Johns Park West**

This large community park is connected to the multiway trail system. This part of the park has a natural playground and picnic tables.

**Fred Johns Park South**

This is a large playground designed for school aged children (ages 5-12), a picnic shelter, BBQ pits and is connected to the multiway.

**Harry Bienert Playground**

Located in Bridgeport, Harry Bienert Park has a playground, basketball court, and an abundance of open space with lots of opportunities for recreational activities. It also connects the community to the rest of the City via the multiway trail system.

**John Moran Park**

Small neighborhood park with a cute nature themed tot lot.

**Kinsmen Park/John Bole Athletic Park**

The Kinsmen Park and John Bole Athletic Park are connected to the multiway trail system and houses a community hall. It's an active, well-maintained, 4.07-hectare park with plenty of recreational and programming opportunities. The park has a tot lot, outdoor boarded rink, football field, tennis courts, as well as an outdoor fitness area.

**Knie Park**

Nestled in the Suntree neighborhood is a nature themed playground! Climb up the playground and imagine you are exploring a forest. This is a larger park with lots of cool features, come and check it out! Includes things like a cool tree aesthetic, tall slide, and rock-climbing wall.

**Leduc Lions Park**

Located on the north shore of Telford Lake. Enjoy the great outdoors in this natural forested area that connects to the Telford Trail.

**Leduc Estates Playground and St. Benedicts School Playground (next to one another)**

In this fun, nature themed playground kids can crawl, climb, and slide through this unique and fun playground. There is also an Athletic Obstacle Course.

**Lillian Camp Park**

A nature themed playground with benches and connected to the multiway.

**Linsford Park**

The Linsford Park school playground is sure to be a blast for everyone! The playground is wheelchair accessible and has so many options for play that the fun will never run out.

**Mary Marsh Park**

A fun playground ready to be explored and conquered. Come check out the domed climbing structure, test your balance on the pods or climb on the rock wall!

**McKinley Park North/South**

Fun wilderness theme, pretend you are climbing through the woods meeting many little critters! There are two playgrounds, a picnic shelter, BBQ pits, seating areas and multiway that runs through the entire park space.

**Meadowview Dinosaur park**

Built to recognize the Hadrosaur skeleton that was discovered in Meadowview. Children of all ages can explore the prehistoric playground and bring their imagination to life.

**Notre Dame Park**

Adjacent to Notre Dame School in South Park, this park has a backstop, basketball court, a wheelchair accessible playground and picnic tables.





**Outlook Park**

The park is located just north of Allard Avenue and 33 Street, it is completely fenced with a parking lot. There is a winding trail to the top which has picnic tables, information signage and different rest stops provided. This is very much a natural park which provides for waterfowl and scenic views. One of the adjacent ponds is designed to replicate a '7' on a domino with the planting of the vegetation.



**Rainbow Park**

Come explore this huge park that contains an exciting playground that features tons of places to climb.



**Simpson Park**

This park has beautiful old trees, a fun playground to explore and is connected to the multiway.



**Sunshine playground**

Located at the heart of William F. Lede Park, this playground is Canadian themed to celebrate Canada's 150th birthday. There is an outdoor Fitness Park located next to the playground.



**Willow Park East/West**

Situated behind Willow Park School, Willow Park includes a playground, soccer field, two backstops and a basketball court and picnic tables. Rope features, slides, climbing features and cute design!



**West Haven Public School Playgrounds**

This park has a castle themed playground and a pirate ship themed playground with the highest playground structure in Leduc.
