<p>Who can participate in this program?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • City of Leduc and/or rural Leduc County residents - proof of residency is required. • Family must be considered in financial need under Stat Canada Low Income cut-offs http://www.statcan.gc.ca/pub/75f0002m/2014003/tbl/tbl02-eng.htm <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Verification of income may be requested (i.e. Last two paystubs, Notice of Assessment from previous year taxes, a current bank statement or AB Health Benefits approval letter). ○ <i>Adults are defined as individuals 18 years of age and older.</i> • Those who do not meet the above criteria may be assessed on a case by case basis.
<p>How much does the program cover?</p>	<p>A maximum of \$200 of funding is available per applicant per year.</p> <p>Please Note: <i>Funding cannot be used for activities covered by other streams of funding (e.g. Canadian Tire Jumpstart funding, Kid Sport, etc.)</i></p>

All applications will be held in the strictest confidence.



<p>What types of activities do we fund?</p>	<p>Arts or culture programs that take place a minimum of once a week for the duration of 5 consecutive weeks. (e.g. Painting, music, pottery, etc.)</p> <p><i>Please Note: Due to program guidelines, we are unable to provide funding to entire organizations or groups.</i></p>
<p>Will the program fund registration fees?</p>	<p>Funding covers registration and program fees to a maximum of \$200 per year.</p>
<p>What time of year can I apply?</p>	<p>Anytime between January 15th and December 01st. Applicants/organizations are encouraged to apply within 30 days of a program beginning.</p>
<p>How long does it take to receive funding?</p>	<p>Organizations should receive a cheque within 4-6 weeks of application approval.</p>
<p>Can I receive funding for more than one activity?</p>	<p>Yes; however, you may only access \$200 per year in total.</p>
<p>Can more than one individual in the same family receive funding?</p>	<p>Yes</p>
<p>What is an endorser, and how do I obtain one?</p>	<p>An endorser is a community leader that can verify your financial need or current situation.</p> <p>All applicants require an endorser to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide an endorsement letter for the applicant <p style="text-align: center;"><u>OR</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sign off on application form as the endorser. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Acceptable Endorser: (not a complete list) Principal, Guidance Counselor, Teacher, Social Worker, Clergy, FCSS or Community Services Staff. ○ Not Acceptable Endorsers: (not a complete list) Friends, Family, Relatives, or Neighbour. <p>If you do not have access to one of the above acceptable endorsers, you may contact the City of Leduc to set up an appointment with a member of the FCSS staff.</p>
