

## NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

### Chippewa Road & Huron Drive Street Improvements Construction Update

The concrete in the **green** area is nearing completion, but with the rain delays this week it will still be ongoing next week. We are still planning to get started on the road reconstruction of the **orange** area on Monday, June 14<sup>th</sup>. Please note that if you are one of the houses that front the area highlighted in **orange**, you will lose access to the road once the road closure is in place next week. During construction we ask that residents park in the rear laneway to allow for construction to proceed. **All three accesses to the interior lanes will be OPEN for garbage collection going forward, therefore you can put your garbage out to the rear lane as per normal.** We will be closing the north and south lane accesses to pour the concrete after garbage collection happens on Monday, June 14<sup>th</sup> and it will be open for garbage collection on June 21<sup>st</sup>. While the two lane crossings are being poured and curing only one interior crossing will be available for residents to access the interior laneways (refer to sketch below).

Residents will be expected to cooperate with the daytime parking restrictions in order to allow for the street improvement construction in front of their property to safely progress. **We thank-you all for your patience and cooperation during the inconveniences due to construction!** We continue to ask that residents keep their distance from the equipment; maintain 2m separation from any workers; and watch their children for all of the obvious safety reasons.

Please advise the Excavation/Gravel contact below if your property has sprinklers within one meter of the concrete that may require special attention. Landscape restoration will not take place until after the paving is complete in the fall.
