

# Sprinkle Ball Ornament

## Materials:

- Sprinkles (small round)
- 1 ½" Styrofoam balls
- Mod podge
- Push pins (with plastic head)
- String
- Scissors
- paintbrush
- Bowl

## Instructions:

1. Put Round Sprinkles in Bowl.
2. Cover Half of Styrofoam Ball with mod podge using the paintbrush.
3. Dip Mod Podge side of ball into bowl of sprinkles and leave to dry.
4. Once dry, coat other side of Styrofoam ball in mod podge and dip into sprinkles. Leave to dry.
5. Using a fair amount of mod podge, cover half of sprinkle ball to seal in the sprinkles. Let set and then repeat with the other side.
6. Cut some string and knot the ends together.
7. Twist the ends around a push pin and push into Styrofoam ball for hanging.

# Bottle Cap Macarons

## Materials:

- Bottle Caps
- Glitter
- Glue Gun & Glue
- Paint
- String
- Paintbrush

## Instructions:

1. Paint two bottle caps with acrylic paint. (You will likely need to do about 3-4 coats, letting the paint dry between each coat.)
2. Cut string and tie a knot. Add a bead of glue to the inside of one bottle cap and stick the knot of the string to form the hanger for the ornament.
3. Run a bead of glue along the outside edge of one of the bottle caps, working quickly so that the glue doesn't dry. Line up the ridges of the bottle caps and place the second bottle cap onto the first one and press together. Hold for a few seconds while the glue dries.
4. Add a bead of glue around the outside edge, along the seam of the caps and then gently dip in the glitter. Work in sections, about a quarter at a time to make sure that the glue doesn't dry before you get the glitter on.
5. Let set.

# Felt Cupcakes

## Materials:

- Felt
- 1 ½" Styrofoam Balls
- Mini Cupcake Wrappers
- Push Pins (with plastic head)
- String
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Glue Gun & Glue

## Instructions:

1. Cut out 20-25 small circles from piece of felt (about ½ - ¾" in diameter).
2. Use the glue gun to place a bead of glue onto the Styrofoam ball.
3. Place a felt circle on the pointy end of the pencil and push into the Styrofoam ball on top of the glue bead. This should slightly ruffle the circle edges.
4. Repeat process with all felt circles, until the Styrofoam ball is about half covered in felt.
5. Put a bead of glue into mini cupcake wrapper and push in Styrofoam ball so that the felt side sticks out of the wrapper.
6. Stick in push pins to look like sprinkles on ball.
7. Cut string and tie ends into a knot. Wrap knot around push pin and put into cupcake to make a hanger.

# Sugar Cookies

## Materials:

- Wood Shapes
- Paint
- Sprinkles (long cylindrical)
- Mod Podge
- String
- Paintbrush
- String
- Glue Gun & Glue

## Instructions:

1. Paint wood shape a cookie colour (brown or tan.) Leave to dry.
2. Paint "icing" on top of shape, leaving a small edge on the wood shape. Use any colour of your choosing. Leave to dry.
3. Paint top of wood shape with mod podge, and add sprinkles on top. Leave to dry.
4. Using a fair amount of mod podge, cover top of wood shape and sprinkles to seal.
5. Cut a string and tie ends into a knot. Add a small bead of glue onto the back of the wood shape and stick string to add a hanger.

# Donuts

## Materials:

- Salt Dough
- Paint
- Sprinkles (your choice)
- Mod Podge
- String
- Scissors

## Instructions:

1. Make salt dough. Mix 2 cups flour,  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup of salt and  $\frac{3}{4}$  cup of hot water. Knead until smooth.
2. Shape salt dough into donut shapes and place on baking tray. Bake in oven set to 300 degrees for 1-2 hours, or until firm to touch. Let cool.
3. If desired, paint donut tan or brown (not required since colour after baking salt dough is a light tan.)
4. Use acrylic paint to add "icing" to the donut in your choice of colour. Leave to dry.
5. Add a layer of mod podge on the donut and add sprinkles of your choice. Let dry.
6. Using an adequate amount of mod podge, cover sprinkles and donut to seal. Leave to dry.
7. Tie a piece of string around the donut for hanging.

# Gumdrops

## Materials:

- Plastic Easter Eggs
- Candy Sugar
- Felt
- Mod Podge
- String
- Scissors
- bowl
- Glue Gun & Glue

## Instructions:

1. Using the top half of the plastic egg, trace open end onto piece of felt.
2. Cut out traced felt circle, and use glue gun to attach to the bottom of the egg.
3. Fill bowl with candy sugar.
4. Cover plastic part of egg with mod podge, and roll in candy sugar. Let dry.
5. Once dry, use an adequate amount of mod podge to seal candy sugar onto egg.
6. Cut string and tie ends into knot. Add a bead of glue on top of plastic egg and add string to make a hanger.

# Lollipops

## Materials:

- Felt
- Straws
- Push Pin
- Glue Gun & Glue
- Scissors
- String

## Instructions:

1. Cut  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips from two different colours of felt. (if you would like the swirls to be thicker, cut 1" strips and then fold in half lengthwise and glue together.) Strips should be at least 6" in length.
2. Place two different coloured strips on top of each other and glue one end.
3. Roll the strips together until you reach the end. (One strip will end up longer than the other after rolling, so you will have to trim this strip.) Glue ends of the swirl so it doesn't unravel.
4. Cut  $\frac{1}{4}$ " strip of felt (or use ribbon) and make a bow.
5. Cut a straw into a piece about  $2\frac{1}{2}$  - 3" long.
6. Use glue gun to attach straw and bow to the lollipop.
7. Cut string and tie ends into a knot. Wrap the knot around a push pin and stick into the top of the lollipop to form the hanger.

# Wrapped Candies

## Materials:

- Felt
- Push Pin
- Glue Gun & Glue
- Scissors
- String

## Instructions:

1. Cut ½" strips from two different colours of felt. (if you would like the swirls to be thicker, cut 1" strips and then fold in half lengthwise and glue together.) Strips should be at least 6" in length.
2. Place two different coloured strips on top of each other and glue one end.
3. Roll the strips together until you reach the end. (One strip will end up longer than the other after rolling, so you will have to trim this strip.) Glue ends of the swirl so it doesn't unravel.
4. Cut out two felt squares, about 1" in diameter. Cut a wave pattern into one side of each square.
5. Pinch the other side (opposite of the wave side) and use glue gun to set. This will make the wrapper sides of the candy.
6. Use glue gun to attach these to the felt candy shape.
7. Cut string and tie ends into a knot. Wrap the knot around a push pin and stick into the top of the wrapped candy to form the hanger.



# Gingerbread Star

## Materials:

- Felt (Brown and White)
- Binder Clip
- Scissors
- Glue Gun

## Instructions:

1. Cut out brown felt into shape of a star.
2. Cut strips of white felt into a wave pattern.
3. Use glue gun to add white felt strips onto outer edge of the brown star.
4. Use glue gun to add a binder clip onto back of gingerbread star. This is to clip to the top of your tree!
