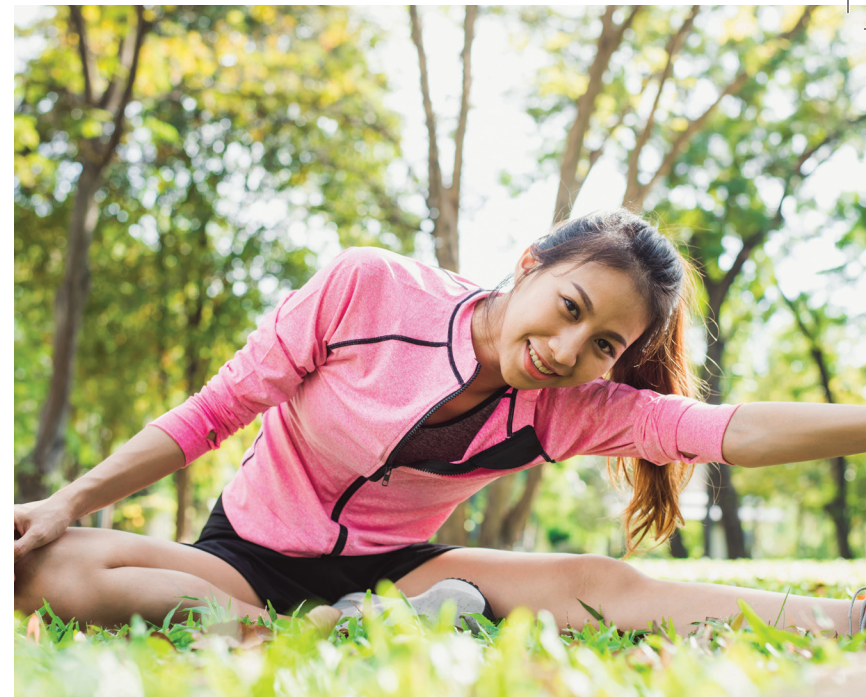
Walk with the Doc
