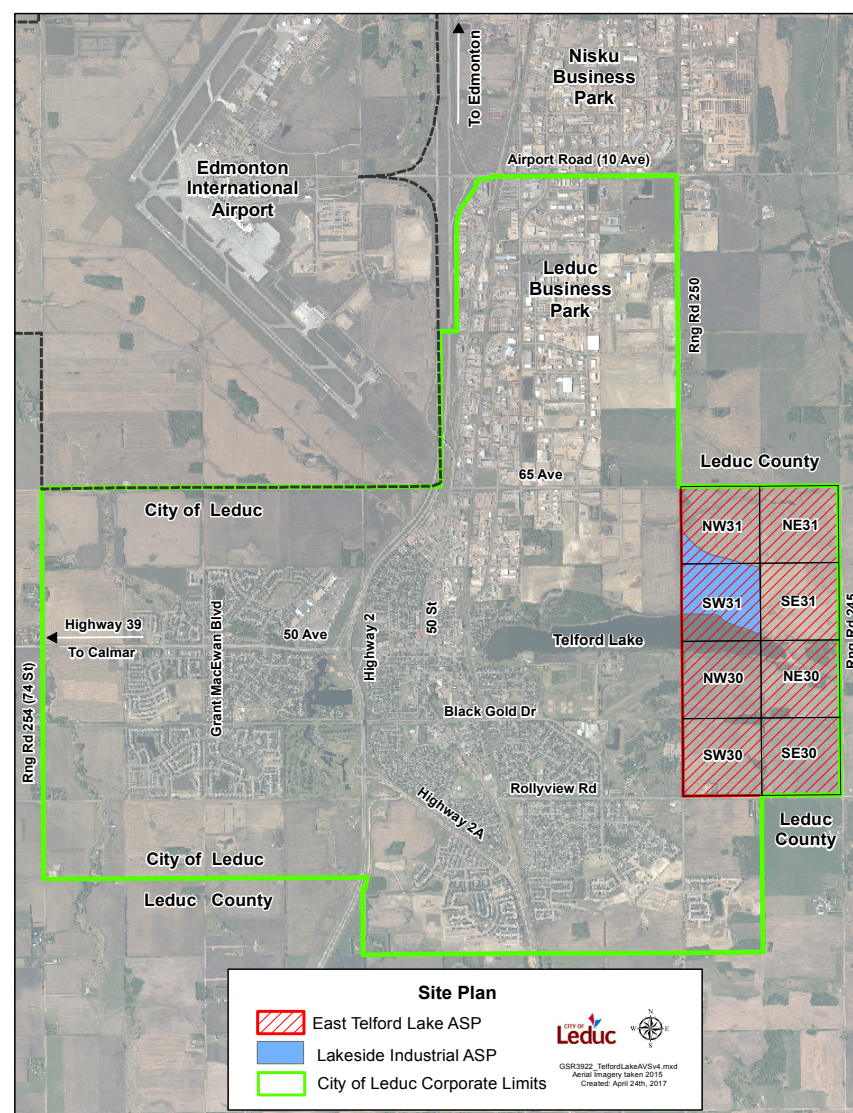

NOTICE OF OPEN HOUSE

The City of Leduc invites residents, organizations and agencies of the Leduc region to attend a Public Open House on the proposed **East Telford Lake Area Structure Plan (ETLASP)**.

The purpose of this event is to share the background information collected so far and gather feedback from open house attendees in order to develop a vision for this area that will enable responsible growth. For this plan, the City of Leduc has retained the services of Stantec and MXD Development Strategists to lead the engagement strategy as well as for the development of both the land-use concept and the servicing plan.



The open house will take place at **Telford House, 4907 - 46 Street, Leduc on June 28, 2017, between the hours of 5 and 7:30 p.m.** Representatives from the City of Leduc, Stantec and MXD will be available to answer questions and discuss the proposed plan with attendees.

DEVELOPMENT APPROVALS

Under Land-use Bylaw 809-2013 discretionary uses must be published to allow the opportunity for citizens to determine if they wish to appeal the decision of the development officer. Conditions of approval for the following may be viewed at the City of Leduc, Planning and Development Department.

Proposed Development Approvals:

- Discretionary use in a IL - Light Industrial District Land Use Classification for **Temporary Pipe Storage** at Plan 1423781, Block 2, Lot 11A being **6632 - 44 Street**, Leduc. Issued May 30, 2017.

Persons may appeal the decision of the development officer to the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board. Appeals and a \$125 appeal fee must be submitted within fourteen (14) days from the date of publication of this paper.

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
