

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION #3

54 Avenue - Road Reconstruction

Now that the first stage of construction is paved within the **green** area below we will need to close 54 Avenue within the **orange** area between 49 Street and 50 Street to complete the road reconstruction. The **orange** area will be closed starting Monday, July 12 throughout July and August.



Please note that the residents on the west side of 49 Street between 52 and 54 Avenue will need to put their garbage to the front of their property on garbage collection day until 54 Avenue is open.

Please advise the contacts below if your property has sprinklers that will require special attention. Once any concrete is poured, we ask that it is not driven on for at least 7 days to allow for it to cure properly and obtain the strength required to support a vehicle weight.

Residents and businesses will be expected to cooperate with the road closures and parking restrictions in order to allow for the underground construction and road reconstruction in front of their property to progress. During construction there will be traffic flow interruptions and we ask for your patience and cooperation. **We also ask that residents keep their distance from the equipment; maintain 2m separation from any workers; and watch their children for all of the obvious safety reasons.** We apologize in advance for any inconveniences due to construction and we thank you for your cooperation during any inconvenient times.
