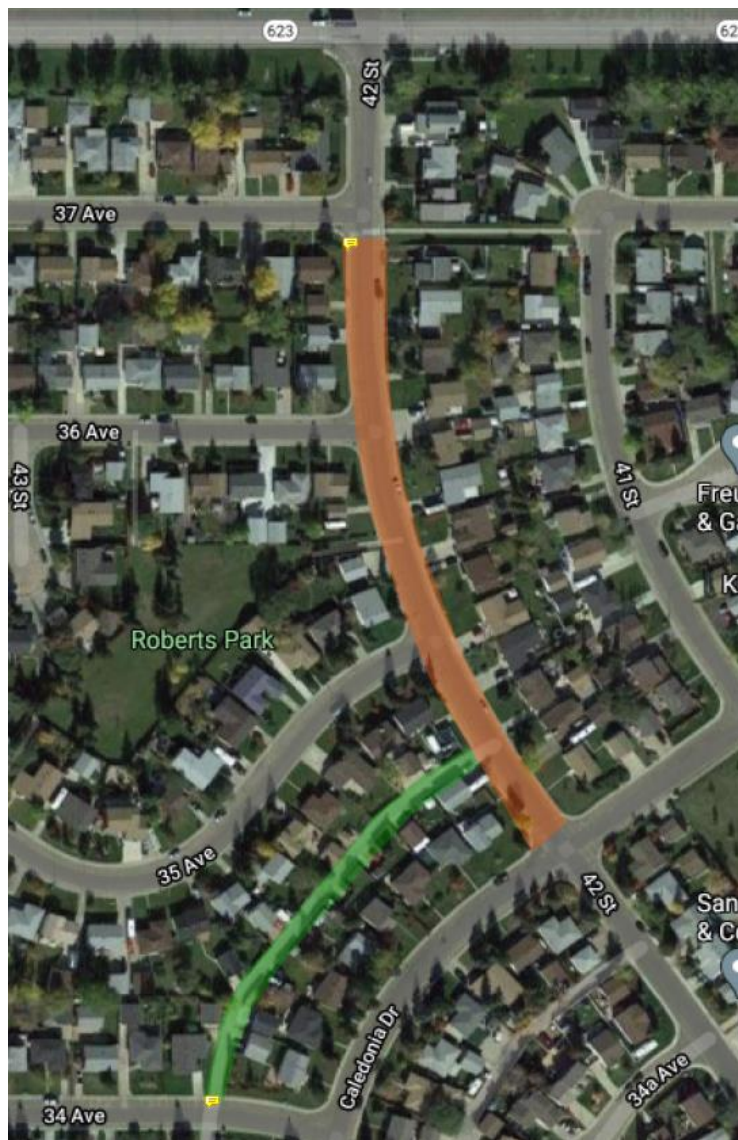


NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

42 Street Reconstruction - Road Closure

We would like to update the residents in the area regarding the construction in the area. We will be paving Caledonia Drive next week with the intention to open Caledonia Drive to traffic on July 2nd. The next stage of construction involves closing 42 Street from Caledonia Drive to 37 Avenue as shown in the image below in orange. The monowalk on the east side of 42 Street has been constructed in advance to provide a hard surface for better pedestrian access in the area during the road reconstruction. The intersection of Caledonia Drive and 42 Street will remain open for now, but this intersection will also be closed for about one week at a later date. **We thank-you for your continued patience and apologize for the inconveniences with regards to construction!**



If you are a resident that has rear lane garbage collection within the **green** highlighted laneway you will need to put your garbage to the front of your property on garbage collection day starting **July 8th**. The garbage truck will collect your bins at the front of your property. If you live outside of the green area you can put your garbage out as you would normally. We will be tagging your address on your bins where we need to arrange for bin relocation on garbage collection day. Addresses on the bins is so we can return your bin to the correct address after collection. **Please park in your driveways or rear laneway if you have this option to allow additional street parking for the residents that will not have access to their driveway when the road is closed.**

During construction there will be traffic flow interruptions and we ask for your patience and cooperation for construction to safely progress during the road reconstruction. We also ask that residents keep their distance from the equipment; maintain 2m separation from any workers; and watch their children for all of the obvious safety reasons. **Once again, we apologize in for any inconveniences due to construction and we thank you for your cooperation during these inconvenient times.**
