

## NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

## 42 Street Reconstruction - Road Closure

We would like to update the residents in the area regarding the ongoing construction. Now that the first lift of asphalt has been completed for the south half of 42 Street (from Caledonia Drive to 36 Avenue) we are planning to start the reconstruction for the last stage the week of August 16. The next stage of construction involves closing 42 Street from 36 Avenue to Rollyview Road as shown on the image below in orange. For the next stage of construction, we encourage residents in the area to plan their commuting by using Caledonia Drive to Coady Blvd or to Pioneer Road. We thank-you for your continued patience and apologize for the inconveniences with regards to construction!



Please continue to put your garbage bins to the front of your property and we will relocate the bins where a garbage truck does not have access (from 36 Avenue to Rollyview Road). We will be tagging your address on your bins where we need to arrange for bin relocation on garbage collection day. Addresses on the bins is so we can return your bin to the correct address after collection. Please park in your driveways or rear laneway if you have this option to allow additional street parking for the residents that will not have access to their driveway when the road is closed.

During construction there will be traffic flow interruptions and we ask for your patience and cooperation for construction to safely progress during the road reconstruction. We also ask that residents keep their distance from the equipment; maintain 2m separation from any workers; and watch their children for all of the obvious safety reasons. Once again, we apologize in for any inconveniences due to construction and we thank you for your cooperation during these inconvenient times.
