

Proclamation

Treaty Six Day

Aug. 23, 2022

WHEREAS; on August 23, 1876, Treaty No. 6 was first signed between the First Peoples and the Crown of Great Britain in Fort Carlton, in what is now known as Saskatchewan;

WHEREAS; the signing of Treaty No. 6 is an agreement established through Ceremony, with intentions of sharing the land and living in peaceful coexistence with all peoples without interference in one another's laws, governments, and ways of life;

WHEREAS; the City of Leduc was founded in Treaty No. 6 territory;

WHEREAS; the City of Leduc recognizes that Treaties evolve and will continue to evolve for as long as the sun shines, the grass grows and the waters flow;

WHEREAS; Treaty No. 6 Day recognizes the City of Leduc's connection with the First Peoples of this land;

Now, Therefore be it Resolved; that I, Mayor Bob Young, on behalf of the City of Leduc, do hereby proclaim August 23, 2022, and each year hereafter as Treaty Six Day in the City of Leduc.
