What will the Youth Council (YC) do?

Provide recommendations to Leduc City Council on how to engage and support young people, plan events/initiatives and take other actions related to the interests of young people.

Who will be on the Youth Council?

Two members of city council and up to 13 young people ages 16 - 22.

What kind of time commitment is expected of me?

- YC members are appointed for one year (Jan. Dec., 2020)
- Meetings: approx. 2+ hrs/month
- Event/initiative planning and other work: approx. 5+ hrs/month
- Hosting events/initiatives: approx. 15+ hrs/year
- Attending city events as YC representatives: approx. 8+ hrs/year

When does the Youth Council meet?

Dates for monthly meetings with be determined by the YC members in January. Additional meetings can be added by the YC as needed.

What benefits are there to joining the Youth Council?

- Make an impact in your community
- Learn about and be active in your municipal government
- Meet likeminded people who want to make a difference
- Earn valuable volunteer hours and a great addition to your resume
