

COMMEMORATIVE BENCH PROGRAM

Honour a loved one

The Commemorative Bench Program offers individuals, groups, businesses and organizations the opportunity to donate a park bench to the City of Leduc in honour of a loved one.

Benches benefit all age groups in providing a resting place along a walking trail or allowing for a place to sit while enjoying Leduc's natural areas.

The bench selected for this program is a maintenance free, full frame six foot bench, with a custom 3" x 7" plaque inset located in the middle back. This plaque will be engraved with the inscription provided by the applicant. The inscription to be engraved on the plaque must be presented in a positive, respectful and meaningful way.

How to Participate

Applications are accepted year round and benches are placed between May - September of each year.

Each application must include the name and contact information of the applicant; the requested inscription to be engraved on the plaque that will be placed on the backrest of the bench, and the requested location of the bench. The site will be selected by the applicant and reviewed by municipal staff for its suitability.



The cost of the commemorative bench and plaque installed is \$2,500.

This fee includes the cost of the bench and plaque, engraving, a cement pad (if applicable) and installation. Payment can be made directly to the City of Leduc Engineering Department. Upon receipt of all fees, the City of Leduc will provide a letter confirming the donation, which may be used for income tax purposes.

Cheques are made payable to the City of Leduc and can be mailed or dropped off to the City of Leduc Civic Centre, #1 Alexandra Park, Leduc, AB T9E 4C4.
