POLICY OBJECTIVE:

To define restrictions with respect to solicitation of petitions in city owned facilities.

POLICY:

Definition: Petition is defined as a document requiring addresses and signatures of support from the general public on any question or topic.

No person and/or organization will be allowed to carry a petition throughout City owned facilities for the purpose of soliciting signatures of support.

No person and/or organization will be allowed to leave a petition in a City owned facility and if such a petition is left in a city owned facility it will be removed from the premises and held in the City Clerk's office.

A person and/or organization can however remain at the entrance to a City owned facility and solicit signatures on a petition. If complaints are received from a member of the public regarding the conduct of the person and/or organization, City staff may ask the person and/or organization to leave the premises entirely.

No City of Leduc employee shall, during working hours, solicit other employees or members of the public for signatures on a petition.

If an employee is found to contravene this policy necessary disciplinary action will result.
