

Fieldhouse Guidelines

A guide to helping everyone have a fun and fair experience.

Casual Play Only

All fieldhouse use is for casual, drop-in recreational play.

Organized formats (e.g. round robins, leagues, lessons) are not permitted during drop-in activity times.

Share the Fieldhouse

Be considerate of others waiting to play. Rotate through games to give everyone a fair chance.

Respect all members and participants, their diverse abilities, ages, and desire to participate. All users are expected to participate in a safe and controlled manner and show respect for others and the rules.

Supervision Requirements

Children 7 years of age and under must be actively supervised and remain within arm's reach by a responsible person 14 years of age or older.

Wristbands and Admission

Designated wristbands must be always worn in proof-of-payment areas.

Footwear

Clean, indoor athletic shoes with non-marking soles are required on all playing surfaces.

How to Borrow Equipment

Fieldhouse equipment is available for leisure drop-in activities. Sign out equipment at East Guest Services with a piece of collateral (e.g. membership card).

Return all borrowed equipment when finished.

Please note, we reserve the right to change the activities and equipment allowed on the fieldhouses at anytime.

Food and Beverage

No food and beverages are allowed in the fieldhouse area of play except non-glass water bottles with secure lids.

Outside Music

Personal or outside music is not permitted in the fieldhouse area of play.

General Reminders

Fieldhouse Guidelines are to enhance your experience during your time of play. It does not replace the City of Leduc, Recreation Services Conditions of Use and Expectations.
