

Indoor Playground Guidelines

A guide to having a fun, safe and enjoyable indoor play experience.

Wristbands and Admission

- Designated wristbands must be always worn in proof-of-payment areas. Children 3 - 7 years of age must wear a wristband to play in the Indoor Playground.

Age Access

- Designed specifically for children 7 years of age and under. Older children are welcome to enjoy the other exciting areas of our facility.

Supervision Requirements

- In accordance with the facility's Active Supervision policy, children 7 years of age or under cannot be left unsupervised. They must be accompanied by a supervisor 14 years of age or older. Supervision ratio is 1:6.

Sock Only Zone

- To help keep the playground clean, please leave shoes and outdoor footwear on the boot racks in the hallway. Everyone in the playground, including supervisors, is required to wear socks. Strollers may be parked just outside the door.

Food and Beverage

- No food and beverages are allowed. Snacks and other drinks may be enjoyed at the tables in the lobby.

Furniture

- Do not move benches, play structures, and large toys.

Photography and Privacy

- Photography and video recording is not permitted in washroom or where signage is posted restricting these activities.
- Avoid capturing others in photos or videos without their consent.

Share the Indoor Playground

- Our playground is enjoyed by users of many ages and abilities. Please play safely, walk at all times, and show kindness and respect for others and the rules.

General Reminders

- Indoor Playground guidelines are to enhance the experience during play. It does not replace the City of Leduc, Recreation Services Conditions of Use and Expectations.
