## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What is the difference between STAY N' PLAY and POP UP N' PLAY?**

STAY N' PLAY runs at designated locations and scheduled times.

POP UP N' PLAY is a roving program with no set schedule. We pop up in select communities and bring the fun to you!

### **Where can I find if PARKS drop-in programs are closed?**

Check the Live Leduc Mobile App for real-time updates, or contact Guest Services at 780-980-7120 during business hours (visit [www.leduc.ca/LRC](http://www.leduc.ca/LRC) for details).

### **What does weather dependent mean for the PARKS program?**

Outdoor programs may be modified or canceled due to weather such as rain, thunder, extreme temperatures, high UV, air quality warnings, or site conditions. Updates will be posted on the Live Leduc Mobile App.

### **Can my child come to the PARKS program alone?**

No. PARKS is not a daycare. Parents or guardians must stay on site and are responsible for supervising their children at all times.

### **Will there be any activities for my younger children (ages 5 and under)?**

Activities are designed for ages 6-12, but younger children are welcome to participate with active parent involvement. Children 5 and under require parent support and activity modifications.

### **What should my child bring?**

Please send your child with a full water bottle, hat, secure athletic footwear, and weather-appropriate clothing. Sunscreen and bug spray should be applied before arriving. Staff provide activity equipment only.

### **Will the PARKS program staff perform first aid on my child?**

No. Parents are responsible for providing first aid. Staff will call 911 if emergency assistance is needed.

### **What if my child needs to use the bathroom?**

Port-a-potties may be available, but parents are responsible for taking their child to the washroom.

### **Will there be water for my child?**

No, please send your child a full water bottle or they will need to return home for a drink.

### **Does my child need to bring my own equipment?**

No. All activity equipment is provided. Personal equipment is welcome, but the program is not responsible for lost or damaged items.

### **Who will enforce park/playground rules?**

Everyone is responsible for following park and playground rules as well as being respectful.
