

Outdoor Pool Guidelines

The City of Leduc is committed to fostering a safe, respectful, and inclusive environment for all. By following these guidelines, you help make every visit safe, fun, and enjoyable for everyone.

Conduct and Behaviour

- Abusive language, inappropriate conduct, profane language, and disrespectful or aggressive behaviour are not tolerated.
- Staff reserve the right to ask individuals to leave for such behaviour and may issue a suspension or permanent ban from the facility.
- Patrons using fraudulent or discarded wristbands without paying the required admission may be suspended.
- Everyone belongs here. Everyone has the right to safely attend and participate in City of Leduc programs, services, activities, and events.

Photography and Privacy

- Photography and video recording is not permitted in washroom or changeroom spaces or where signage is posted restricting these activities.
- Avoid capturing others in photos or videos without their consent.

Wristbands and Admission

- Designated wristbands must be always worn in proof-of-payment areas.
- Refusal to wear a wristband will result in denial of access to these spaces.
- Wristbands from previous days must be removed before entry.

Health and Safety

- All patrons use the facility at their own risk and are responsible for their personal health and safety.
- The City of Leduc is not liable for injuries or accidents related to participation in activities.
- Patrons should evacuate the pool(s) and follow the lifeguard instructions when a whistle or alarm is sounded.
- Report injuries, accidents, or equipment issues immediately to facility staff.
- No running on the pool deck or in changeroom areas.
- Aggressive play, wrestling, or other rough play that result in injury is prohibited in the pool or on the pool deck.

Weather Closures

- Pool will close at the first sound of thunder or sight of lightning and remain closed until 30 minutes after the last sign.
- Public Swim is cancelled if the temperature is less than 14 degrees Celsius or if weather conditions interfere with safe lifeguard supervision.

Supervision Requirements

- Children 7 years of age and under must be actively supervised and remain within arm's reach by a responsible person 14 years of age or older.
- Supervision ratio is 4:1.

Swim Test Requirements

- All swimmers who appear to be 15 years of age or under wanting to access the deep-water area or wear a leg-binding device will be required to complete a swim test.
- Please report to a lifeguard on duty during each visit to complete the test and receive a mark indicating successful completion for that day.

Swim Attire and Personal Equipment

- Wear proper and clean swimming attire.
- Have infants and toddlers wear snug fitting swim diapers – regular diapers are not designed for swimming and can leak.
- Individuals who are incontinent should wear protective, water-resistant swimwear while in the pool.
- Tempered glass goggles are not permitted.
- Turn off and store cell phones, cameras, and other recording devices.

Locker Use

- Secure personal belongings. Free lockers available.
- Lockers are intended for same-day use only.

Food and Beverage

- Food and drinks are permitted in the grass area only. No food and beverages are allowed in the changerooms or on the pool deck.
- Patrons who are intoxicated will not be permitted to use the Outdoor Pool.
- All glass is prohibited in the pool changerooms, on the pool deck.

Please Remember

- Shower before entering the pool – wash off sweat, dirt and oils from your skin.
- Wash hands using soap after using the washroom or changing diapers.
- Stay out of the water if you are not feeling well – diarrhea, nausea or dizziness.
